Project name	Community Sentiment Survey
Project reference	NGR 2306019
Research dates:	28th August - 1st September 2023
Target population:	The target population for the research was Australian residents across Sydney, Melbourne, and Brisbane aged 18+.
Research methodology:	The research comprised of a 15-minute self-complete online survey with n=1,203 participants (Sydney n=403, Melbourne n=400, Brisbane n=400) sourced from an ISO accredited market research panel.
Weighting approach:	The data was weighted using ABS Census population statistics on age, gender, location, and education to match the estimated population of Australian residents aged 18+ across Sydney, Melbourne, and Brisbane. The total effective sample size after weighting was approximately 64%, equating to a margin of error of approximately +/-3.6% (at the 95% confidence interval).
Research questions:	A combination of single choice, multiple choice and open-ended (text response) questions were used in the research. All questions and response options were displayed in full during interviews.
